


THE GREAT WALL OF LANGSTONE VILLAGE - Langstone flood defence plan

Coastal Partners have advised they will use the delayed start of construction to finesse designs. One design the committee thinks needs finessing is the wall proposed to be built over parts of the winkle market and the adjacent wall along the foreshore.



The wall will be 50cm thick, with a height below the windows of the winkle market but similar height to the adjoining wall (Martin Murphys wall). It covers part of the width of the existing footpath which will need widening into the foreshore. The top of the wall will be convenient for sitting on or for left pub glasses, empty cans and crisp packets



From the foreshore, the wall turns 90 degrees at the winkle market, proceeding up Langstone high street to the post for the flood gate.

Is this really the best on offer. What alternatives were considered.
