This Order is made by Havant Borough Council as the local planning authority, under Section 257 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the Footpaths to which this Order relates in order to facilitate the construction of three clay-cored sea defence embankments to be carried out in accordance with planning permission PP-06368234.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The length of Footpaths over the land shown on the attached plan and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council alternative Footpaths as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold black dashed line on the attached plan.
- 3. The diversion of the Footpaths shall have effect on the date on which the Council certifies that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the Footpaths are diverted there is apparatus under in on over along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they had before.

SCHEDULE

<u> Part 1</u>

Description of site of existing Footpaths

Footpath 45 - which currently runs along the existing sea defence providing a route between Harts Farm Way and the junction of Footpaths 49 and 51 and shown on the plan attached to the Order.

Footpath 49 – which provides a route between Southmoor Lane and the junction of Footpaths 45 and 51 and shown on the plan attached to the Order.

Part 2

Description of site of alternative Footpaths

Footpath 45 – The diverted path will be positioned along the existing adjacent green lane permissive path, providing a diverted route of approximately 200 metres between Footpaths 45 and 49.

Footpath 49 – This will follow the same route as the existing Havant Footpath 49 along the top of the new Main Rear Embankment for a distance of approximately 350 metres.
